## 2019

Welcome back to 2019. We have started with a school roll of 207 and everyone seems happy to be back.

There has been a temporary change to the staffing as Jennie Watson has gone on leave for Term 1. Fortunately Paula Akhtar has agreed to cover Term 1 - Paula knows the children and the school so any disruption to the children will be minimal. As Jennie is the Assistant Principal and has responsibilities beyond the classroom Jo Harris will be taking these over for Term 1. This means her Fridays will be out of the class with Mrs Nicola Snook teaching alongside Mrs Sheppard. Nicola taught at the school a few years ago before leaving to start her family and we are pleased to welcome her back.

## WALK YOUR WHEELS - RESPECT

Over the New Year break I have had cause on more than one occasion to reflect on RESPECT - which also happens to be one of the school's key values.

Today I looked back at an article that provided a good perspective on respect that you may like to read and think about and discuss with your children.

*"Teaching our children the difference between respect and obedience" by Dr Justin Coulson*

- *Respect means that we show due regard for the feelings, wishes and rights of others (including property and possessions).*
- *Obedience means that we follow the instructions of an authority figure.*

*"Children grow into caring, respectful kids if they themselves feel respected and cared for. An atmosphere of respect is more likely to produce a child who can be respectful. And a natural outcome of this respect is that our children may choose to be obedient, not out of compulsion, but because they have chosen it for themselves and it feels good."*

Teaching children respect is about getting children to make good decisions for the right reasons. As adults we choose to follow vehicle speed limits not just because we might get caught and get a ticket but because we know that travelling at a safe speed will keep ourselves and others safe – we are respecting ourselves, others and the rules.

A number of our children ride scooters or bikes to and from school. When they enter or leave the school grounds we expect children not to ride their scooters (before and after school) for much the same reasons as above - safety and speed. Unfortunately a lot of children are riding not walking their wheels. If they see me or another teacher they usually jump off ... compliance through obedience.

If they were respectful - of others and the rule - they would “walk their wheels” and demonstrate compliance through respect.

**We will be emphasising “Walk Your Wheels” for the rest of the term.**

### **SCHOOL CARPARK USE**

**No parent vehicles should enter the school carpark before or after school.  
Please do not park in the carpark or use it to drop children off.**

The school car park was originally designed with a drop off zone. After some problems in 2015 we stopped using the drop off zone. It was planned and built when the school roll was significantly lower and the increased traffic led to congestion, inappropriate speed, passing and parking that posed **a risk to the children** and adults walking into the school. There was also an incident where a child was bumped by a car (fortunately no injury) and this incident highlighted a design fault which does not allow sufficient separation of vehicles from pedestrians. Since then the left entry gate into the carpark has always remained closed with a sign on it clearly stating **‘No Entry’**.
